## PSLV-C35 Successfully Launches Eight Satellites into Two Different Orbits in a Single Flight

Sriharikota.: In its thirty seventh flight (PSLV-C35), ISRO's Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle successfully launched the 371 kg SCATSAT-1 Satellite along with seven co-passenger satellites today morning (September 26, 2016) from Satish Dhawan Space Centre SHAR, Sriharikota. This is the thirty sixth consecutively successful mission of PSLV. The total weight of all the eight satellites carried on-board PSLV-C35 was 675 kg. PSLV-C35 is the first PSLV mission to launch satellites carried onboard into two different orbits. This PSLV mission was the longest of the PSLV missions conducted till date and was completed in 2 hours 15 minutes and 33 seconds after lift-off. After PSLV-C35 lift-off at 0912 hrs (9:12 am) IST from the First Launch Pad with the ignition of the first stage, the sub-

sequent important flight events, namely, strap-on ignitions and separations, first stage separation, second stage ignition, payload fairing separation, second stage separation, third stage ignition and separation, fourth stage ignition and cut-off, took place as planned. After a flight of 16 minutes 56 seconds, the vehicle achieved a polar Sun Syn-



chronous Orbit of 724 km inclined at an angle of 98.1 degree to the equator (very close to the intended orbit) and 37 seconds later the primary satellite SCATSAT-1 was separated from the PSLV fourth stage. After separation, the two solar arrays of SCATSAT-1 satellite were deployed automatically and ISRO's Telemetry, Tracking and Command Network (ISTRAC) at Bangalore took over the control of the satellite. In the coming days, the satellite will be brought to its final operational configuration following which it will begin to provide weather related services using its scatterometer payload. The data sent by SCATSAT-1 satellite will help provide weather forecasting services to user communities through the generation of wind vector products as well as cyclone detection and tracking. Pg2

## PSLV-C35 Successfully Launches ..FromPg1

After the successful separation of SCATSAT-1, the PSLV-C35 mission continued. Still carrying the seven co-passenger satellites, the fourth stage of PSLV coasted over the South polar region and then started ascending towards the Northern hemisphere. A safe distance between the orbiting SCATSAT-1 and PSLV-C35 fourth stage was maintained by suitably manoeuvring the stage. At 1 hour 22 minutes and 38 seconds after lift-off as the fourth stage was in the North polar region, the two engines of PSLV fourth stage were reignited and fired for 20 seconds. As a result of this, it entered into an elliptical orbit measuring 725 km on one side of the Earth and 670 km on the other. And 50 minutes later, as the PSLV fourth stage was again coasting near the south pole, its engines were fired for another 20 seconds. This second firing made the fourth stage to enter into a circular orbit of 669 km height inclined at an angle of 98.2 degree to the equator. 37 seconds later, the Dual Launch Adapter was successfully separated from the PSLV-C35 fourth stage. 30 seconds after this event, ALSAT-1N



was the first co-passenger satellite to be separated successfully. Following this, the NLS-19, PRATHAM, PISAT, ALSAT-1B, ALSAT-2B, and Pathfinder-1 were separated from the PSLV fourth stage in a predetermined sequence thereby successfully completing PSLV-C35 mission. Of the seven co-passenger satellites carried by PSLV-C35, two – PRATHAM weighing 10 kg and PISAT weighing 5.25 kg – are University/Academic institute satellites and were built with the involvement of students from IIT-Bombay and PES University, Bangalore and its consortium, respectively. The remaining five co-passenger satellites were international customer satellites from Algeria (three – ALSAT-1B, ALSAT-2B and ALSAT-1N), Canada (one- NLS-19) and the United States (one – Pathfinder-1). With today's launch, the PSLV's capability to launch satellites into two different orbits has been successfully demonstrated. The total number of satellites launched by India's workhorse launch vehicle PSLV has now reached 121, of which 42 are Indian and the remaining 79 are from abroad.

### 3 Guinness World Records Created in Samajik Adhikarita Shivir, Navsari, Gujarat

New Delhi: September 23, 2016  
Three (3) Guinness World Records were created at Samajik Adhikarita Shivir and Scheme of Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase/Fittings of Aids/Appliances (ADIP) Camp in Navsari, Gujarat on 17th September, 2016. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi graced the occasion as Chief Guest. Expressing his pleasure PM Shri Modi tweeted, "Navsari has set three records has made a mark for itself on the map of the world. Congratulations," on the micro-blogging website.



1. The first record - "Highest number of Oil lamps lit simultaneously at single location" was set on the eve (16th September, 2016) of the Mega camp. An incredible 989 Divyangs (Person with Disabilities) came together to set an all-new record- almost doubling the minimum of 500 participants they needed in order to achieve the title. The challenge was for each person to light the lamp exactly at the same time after a given signal within 30 seconds.

2. The second record 'Biggest Wheelchair Logo' was also broken on 17th September, 2016 in Navsari, Gujarat. The 1,000 participants in

wheelchairs depicted a message saying 'Happy Birthday PM' in Tri-colour. It bettered the previous record of 346 participants that was achieved by Hope Inc. in Moorhead, Minnesota, USA.

3. The third world record 'Most people fitted with Hearing Aid in 8 hours - Single location (600 Hearing Aid) was also set on the same day. Free assistive devices kits were handed out to thousands of Divyangs throughout the weekend, in addition to the hearing aids distributed during the record attempt

Three world records were the part of ADIP camp conducted by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities [Divyangjan], Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and organised by Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India (ALIMCO). It is important to mention here, in the 159th Mega ADIP Camp, which is so far the biggest, 11330 Divyangjan beneficiaries were benefitted. The camp which is held under the ADIP Scheme of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, is in force since 1981. This has been revised and further adopted from April, 01, 2014.

### JNPT Now Harnessing Solar ..FromPg8

This green initiative by JNPT is part of its push towards becoming the most sustainable energy generation port organisation in India. Rooftop solar plants allows the use of roof of buildings, an area which is otherwise not usable, for sustainable energy generation also ensuring financial savings. With this new initiative, JNPT is expected to get a payback on its investment on rooftop solar within 2.5 years due to its high cost of grid electricity (around Rs. 14 per unit).



This 822 KWp of solar rooftop capacity is being installed at an expense of Rs 4.5 crore, supported by a 15% subsidy from SECI (part of Ministry of New and Renewable Energy). The 822 KWp project once commissioned will generate around 9.9 lakh units of electricity thereby saving around Rs.1.08 crore of electricity expense for JNPT in the first year. Out of

this 411 KWp is commissioned at Rooftop solar installation at JNPT premises i.e. Hospital- 234 KW, St. Mary School- 45.6 KW, IES School- 36 KW in the township and Port User Building (PUB)- 96 KW. The renewable energy of 234 KW generated from Rooftop solar installation at hospital has capacity of 25,350 KWh per month and is contributing 80% of approximate present consumption. The total 411

KWp will generate around 4.95 lakh units of electricity in year 1 contributing to 40% of approximate present consumption of these 4 premises, thereby saving around Rs. 0.54 crore of electricity expense for JNPT in the first year. This is a small but a significant step in the Central government's widespread initiative to promote solar energy in our country and will contribute to the government's ambitious target of having 1,00,000 MW of solar capacity installed in India by 2022.

### MICA Missile Firing by 'TIGER' Squadron of IAF

New Delhi : 'Tigers' the first squadron of Indian Air Force, successfully fired the recently acquired long range 'Beyond Visual Range' Air-to-Air MICA missile on a manoeuvring target from Mirage-2000 Upgrade aircraft. The missile achieved a Direct Hit on a target which was much smaller than an actual aircraft and flying at low altitude. The tar-



get was destroyed on missile impact validating the launch envelope of the missile. With the success of this mission, the IAF has become one of the few Air Forces in the world with the capability of such long range Beyond Visual Range Air-to-Air missile. The operational success of this mission confirms a critical capability of Indian Air Force.

The order setting up the panel was issued on September 22. The meeting between the Minister and KVIC Chairman took place just two days earlier on September 20. KVIC has been taking several measures to promote use of Khadi products in the country and abroad ever since Mr. Saxena took charge of the Commission in October 2015.

Among other things, the Commission made an aggressive marketing effort during the second International Yoga Day, which was held across the world with pomp and show on June 21 by selling special yoga kits each of which contained

New Delhi: September 25, 2016

He said people in the Valley have begun to understand the truth and are treading on the path of peace. Mr Modi expressed belief that the Kashmir issue will be solved through dialogue. He said everyone wants normalcy to prevail in the state and go back to their day to day activities. He said peace, unity, compassion and harmony are the paths which will lead towards development and progress. Saying that the responsibility for security of Jammu and Kashmir rests with the government, Mr Modi said government has to take several steps in order to maintain law and order. Mentioning a letter from a student of Class XI, who expressed anguish at Uri attack, Prime Minister said patriotism should lead to adoption of a constructive approach for the benefit of the nation. He recounted how former Prime Minister Lal Bahadur Shastri had given the slogan of Jai Jawan Jai Kisan, during the 1965 war as a wave of patriotism swept the nation. The Prime Minister

drove home the point that nation will reach new heights if each person follows his duties, be he a soldier, a politician or a common man.

Lauding the performance of athletes in the Paralympics at Rio, Mr Modi said the Games changed the way nation looked at Divyngs. He said this year's performance was the best ever at the Games, with a haul of two Gold, one Silver and a Bronze. He lauded the performance of medal winners - Devendra Jhajharia in javelin throw, Mariappan Thangavelu and Varun Shivbhati in high jump, and Dipa



Malik in shot put. Prime minister said in a planned way country will be marching forward for the expansion of para olympics in the country in the coming days. The Prime Minister said these athletes had fought against all odds to become achievers. He expressed awe at the fact that even Olympic records were broken during the Paralympics.

The Prime Minister recounted his feeling of pride during a mega camp in Gujarat last week for Divyngs. He said a new record was created in the Guinness Book of Records during the event as 600 hearing impaired Divyngs were provided hearing aids in 8 hours. Speaking on Swachhta Abhiyan, Mr Modi said citizens have now become more aware on cleanliness. He said it is every citizen's duty to make cleanliness a habit. He said till now 2 crores and 48 lakh toilets have been constructed and 1.5 crore will be constructed in the coming year. The Prime Minister stressed that country must become open defecation free especially for the dignity of women. He said Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, and Kerala are very close to achieving Open Defecation Free status.

This is reflected, amongst others, in the terrorist attacks on 11 and 18 September 16 in Punch and Uri respectively. Almost 20 infiltration attempts have also been foiled by the Army at or close to the Line of Control during this year. During these terrorist attacks and infiltration attempts, we have recovered various stores including GPS and items that clearly indicate their origins in Pakistan. Furthermore, captured terrorists hailing from Pakistan or Pakistan Occupied Kashmir have confessed to their training and arming in Pakistan or territory under its control. The matter had been taken up at highest diplomatic levels and through military channels. India has also offered consular access to these apprehended terrorists for Pakistan to verify their confessions. Furthermore, we had proposed that fingerprints and DNA samples of terrorists killed

in Punch and Uri could be made available to Pakistan for investigation.

Despite our persistent urging that Pakistan respect its January 2004 commitment for not allowing its soil or territory under its control to be used for terrorism against India, there has been no let up in infiltration and terrorist actions from across the Line of Control. If damage was limited, this was primarily due to the efforts of our soldiers deployed in our multi-tiered counter-infiltration grid that has been effective in neutralizing infiltrating terrorists. The Indian Armed Forces have been extremely vigilant in the face of this continuing threat. Based on receiving specific and credible inputs that some terrorist teams had positioned themselves at launch pads along Line of Control to carryout infiltration and conduct terrorist strikes inside Jammu and ..Pg5

# Safety and Security of the passengers is first priority

**1. Escorting of Trains:** RPF/BCT division is ensuring the safety and security of the passengers by escorting 46 trains and guarding all the important stations, with high profile presence besides conducting raids against anti-social elements and prosecuting them.

**2. Women Security:** More thrust has been given on women security by taking many innovative steps such as M-Indicator Mobile Apps, Helpline-182, introduction of exclusive RPF Mahila Vahini and the Whatsapp group with Mahilacommuters. Seminars also organized by Amnesty International NGO for RPF & GRP personnel against Molestation and sexual harassment at work place. Drives also conducted against unauthorized entry of male passengers into women coaches to ensure that safe travel of women passengers. During the year 2015 total 10330 male persons were booked and fine of Rs. 3167380/- was realized. During the current year 2016 (up to August) total 8723 male persons were booked and fine of Rs. 2257361/- was realized.

**Security Helpline:** Help line No. 182 is provided by the W. Rly. and operational at Divisional Security Control Room from 25.11.2014. The said helpline number is manned by Control Room staff 24 x 7. Said help line is pasted and made available on each compartments of suburban trains to make wide publicity is made through print media.

**1.141 Rly. Act. (Alarm Chain Pulling (ACP) cases):** During the year 2015, 731 cases were booked against ACP and fine of Rs. 315165/- was realized. During the current year (up to August) total 613 cases were booked with fine of Rs. 247350/- were realized.

**2.143 Rly. Act (Drive against touts):** 268 touts involved in blocking of reservation including e-ticketing were apprehended by RPF with the seizure of 3771 tickets with value Rs. 1,34,00,847/- in the last year. During the current year up to August, 338 touts involved in blocking of reservation including e-ticketing were apprehended by RPF with the seizure of 4889 tickets with value Rs. 1,18,38,619.29.

**3.144 Rly. Act. (Drive against unauthorized hawkers):** Anti-hawking drive by RPF has led to substantial reduction in this menace with all the foot over bridges (FOBs) of suburban being completely cleared of hawkers paving way for smooth flow of commuter's traffic. Total 12184 hawkers were prosecuted and a fine of Rs. 6388705/- realized. During the current year up to August, 9607 hawkers were prosecuted and a fine of Rs. 4721987/- realized.

**4.145 Rly. Act (Drive against nuisance creators in Railways):** During the year 2015, 8370 cases were booked against nuisance creators and fine of Rs. 3539550/- was realized. During the current year (up to August) total 4097 cases were booked with fine of Rs. 1346920/- were realized.

**5.155 Rly. Act (Drive against passengers travelling in coaches, not reserved for them):** During the year 2015, 25045 cases were booked against persons unauthorized travelling coaches reserved for another passenger and fine of Rs. 7188970/- was realized. During the current year (up to August) total 21723 cases were booked with fine of Rs. 5219370/- were realized.

**6.156 Rly. Act (Drive against passengers travelling on footboard, roof top of the trains)** During the year 2015, 2364 cases were booked against persons travelling on footboard, roof top travelling and fine of Rs. 801250/- was realized. During the current year (up to August) total 4294 cases were booked with fine of Rs. 1317510/- were realized.

**7.162 Rly. Act (Drive against male person travelling in coaches reserved for ladies)** During the year 2015 total 10330 male persons travelling coaches reserved for lady passengers were booked and fine of Rs. 3167380/- was realized. During the current year 2016 (up to August) total 8723 male persons were booked and fine of Rs. 2257361/- was realized.

**8.164 Rly. Act (Drive against persons carrying dangerous goods in Railways):** During the year 2015 total 03 persons were booked while carrying dangerous goods in railways and fine of Rs. 1800/- was realized. During the current year 2016 (up to August) total 04 persons were booked and fine of Rs. 2000/- was realized.

**9.165 Rly. Act (Drive against persons carrying offensive goods in Railways):** During the year 2015 total 01 persons were booked while carrying

offensive goods in railways and fine of Rs. 100/- was realized. During the current year 2016 (up to August) total 19 persons were booked and fine of Rs. 2350/- was realized.

**10.167 Rly. Act (Drive against smoking):** During the year 2015 total 1954 persons were booked for smoking in railways and fine of Rs. 228100/- was realized. During the current year 2016 (up to August) total 1606 persons were booked and fine of Rs. 173050/- was realized.

**11.174 Rly. Act (Drive against obstruction in Railway working):** During the year 2015 total 196 persons were booked for obstruction in Railway working railways and fine of Rs. 76750/- was realized. During the current year 2016 (up to August) total 94 persons were booked and fine of Rs. 22900/- was realized.

**RP (UP) Act cases:** During the year 2016 (upto August) total 61 cases have been detected by RPF with arrest of 100 outsiders and realization of stolen property worth Rs. 528190/-.

**12. Detection of IPC cases:**

In the last year 2015, 93 offenders involved in offences related to the passengers like snatching of Gold chain, theft of luggage, pick pocketing etc. During the current year up to August, 106 such offenders were apprehended and handed over to GRP for

further course of legal action.

**13. Liquor Cases.** During the current year 2016 (up to August), total 201 illicit liquor cases involving 18430 bottles valued Rs. 1241025/- have been detected by RPF and handed over to GRP.

**14. Return of Lost Baggage:** During the last year, 2015, 99 incidents of lost baggage of passengers V/Rs. 21,37,214/- were traced by RPF. Out of which 78 Nos. were handed over to the passengers and 21 Nos. were deposited with LPO. During the current year up to August, 340 cases of lost baggage of passengers V/Rs. 56,50,076/- were detected by RPF. Out of which 274 Nos. were handed over to its owners and 66 Nos. were deposited with LPO.

**15. Destitute children handed over to parents, GRP & Child care**

**centres:** BCT station is among the one out of 20 stations over Indian Railway identified to rescue and help the destitute children as per the directive of NCPDR and Ministry of Railways. During the current year up to August, 283 destitute children were rescued by RPF and handed over to their parents through Child Help Desk an authorized NGO.

**16. Encroachment removal drives:** During the year 2015 total 890 encroachments were removed and during the current year (up to July) total 447 soft & hard encroachments were removed in close co-ordination with Civil Engineering departments and Civil Police.

**17. Untoward Incident, (Manner of Investigation Rules, 2003):** The claims regarding untoward incidents are file with RCT. The claims tribunal adjudgates on the claim based on Investigation Report submitted by RPF through DRM. A huge pendency of claim cases existed in BCT division and the No. of cases investigated with pendency brought down from 2726 to 106.

Kashmir and invarious metros in other states, the Indian Army conducted surgical strikes at several of these launch pads to pre-empt infiltration by terrorists. The operations were focussed on ensuring that these terrorists do not succeed in their design to cause destruction and endanger the lives of our citizens. But we cannot allow the terrorists to operate across the Line of Control with impunity and attack citizens of our country at will. In line with Pakistan's commitment in January 2004 not to allow its soil or territory under its control to be used for attacks against India, we expect the Pakistani army to cooperate with us to erase the menace of terrorism from the region.

## 30% cops who die on duty; die due to heart disease: Mumbai Police

Mumbai : On the eve of World Heart Day, on 29th September, CM Fadnavis and Maharashtra Government launch first ever, massive "Heart Health" screening program, to 'care for the Police Personnel who care for Mumbai. In a first of its kind initiative, the Maharashtra government has announced a collaboration with Asian Heart Institute, India's No. 1 cardiac care hospital, to provide free heart health assessment to thousands of Mumbai police personnel. The program is being spearheaded by Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis. To kick off the initiative, a first batch of 1000 members of Mumbai Police underwent heart health screening at Naigaon and CPR Training was given to 120 members of police at Asian Heart Institute. Dr. Ramakanta Panda, India's top Cardiac Surgeon and his team of doctors, including Dr. Vijay Dsilva, Dr. Nilesh Gautam, Dr. Santosh Dora and Dr. Tilak Suvarna, and medical professionals have chalked out a schedule to cover the 'health screening' of 5000 policemen in phase 1. A total of 5000 Mumbaikars, including 1000 police personnel will also receive CPR training. Hon. CM Devendra Fadnavis who launched the program expressed his heartfelt gratitude to Asian Heart Institute, "Asian Heart Institute and Dr. Ramakanta Panda, have picked up a much needed cause. Prevention is key, especially because in a city like Mumbai, every day can be a new chal-

lenge. I'm particularly happy that 'digital records' will be created for these police personnel. Asian Heart Institute is making a beginning by screening 5000 of the police force, above the age of 40, and I invite other hospitals to also come forward and offer such proposals for departments like the Mumbai Police."

As a part of the program, the following tests are being conducted.

Height, Weight, Blood Pressure, ECG, Complete Blood Count, Urine Routine, HBA1C, Cholesterol, Triglyceride, HDL, LDL, Serum Creatine, Uric Acid, LFT, Doctors Consultation

These results will be put into digital records within 4 working days. Police personnel who are identified as having



heart risk will be shortlisted and provided a Stress Test. Accepting the Hon. CM's comments, Dr. Ramakanta Panda, Vice Chairman and MD, Asian Heart Institute said, "10 to 15 million patients die of heart

disease in India. Indians are thrice as likely to get heart disease, as compared to the west. To add to that, we have 3 times more population than the US and the US spent 20 bn \$ last year on heart care. That's a lot of money. India has to focus on prevention, because we cannot afford this kind of a healthcare burden. Another aspect is that 70% of heart attacks happen at home. A large number of these people die - almost 90%. If you revive the person immediately - through CPR - you can save a life." One third of the US population is trained in CPR. The Asian Heart Institute is planning to train 5000 Mumbaikars this year, including 1000 police personnel, and 25000 Mumbaikars over time. Sonal Panda, Director, Asian Heart Institute, launched a CPR app and asked volunteers to come forward and train for the same. The idea is to create a network of volunteers trained in reviving the heart through CPR, who - through the app - will be able to help at the time of a cardiac emergency. Shri. Sanjay Saxena, Jt CP Crime, standing in for the Hon. Comm of Police, who was away, shared, "For the last 14 years, Asian Heart Institute has been recognised the world over as an exceptional institute. This initiative of caring for those who take care of Mumbai is commendable. Long duty hours and no fixed eating schedule implies that Mumbai's police personnel are not able to keep good health. "Chief Minister Fadnavis and Dr. Panda both were clear to cover as many people as possible, over a long term engagement, with heart risk mitigation and heart health awareness being the key focus. Giving a valedictory note, Anup Kumar Singh, Joint CP confirmed that almost 30% of deaths among police personnel, while on duty are due to cardiac problems. He stressed that this "Heart Health" initiative was timely and that the police personnel would benefit immensely from the same.


